
**Yongergnow's

Things to keep in mind when reviewing this document: The cost of maintaining our existing buildings, many of which are underutilised, each year totals \$228,292.55 or 6.5% of rates. The cost of \$228,292.55 each year over a period of 5 years equates to \$1,141,463 million. Council would like to know whether some of this money could be better spent on improving existing services.

1800-call-a-doc GP trial to continue

The 1800-call-a-doc telehealth GP trial has continued beyond its original 31 March finish date due to its popularity.

The after-hours general practitioner (GP) service has been running since April last year in rural and remote areas in southern WA and will be extended until 30 June 2017.

1800-call-a-doc allows country residents and carers to use their phones and the internet to contact GPs for non-serious acute medical problems when their regular GP is not available.

The service has proven particularly useful at peak holiday times and for communities that do not have regular access to GP services.


