Book Fair Tuesday 15th of August

A great opportunity to dress up and immerse ourselves in the world of Literature. As usual our staff and students embraced the moment enjoying a morning of fun, fiction and real life accounts. Even the legendary song lyricist and story teller Bob Dylan came "Blowin' in the Wind" to host our morning festivities. Of course there was the traditional Book Fair parade, followed by the Book Quiz and Story Time. In all, a great success as usual with students and parents showing great interest in the many literary delights, purchasing nearly a \$1000.00 worth of books. An outstanding effort. Thanks to all the staff and particularly Mrs Thompson for your organisation of this engaging event.

Musica Viva Excursion: B'Tutta Percussion Quartet - Bremer Bay Town Hall Thursday 24th August

Last week staff and students were treated to an awesome performance from this highly acclaimed Sydney based percussion quartet. Packed into the Bremer Bay Town Hall students from Ongerup, Gairdner, Bremer Bay and Jerramungup were exposed to an array of percussion sounds and instruments from these talented performers. The interactive nature of the show allowed students to join in participate and even create and conduct their own percussive piece of music. In all a highly engaging performance - well done boys!

InCAS Testing - Term Three

Last year we commenced Interactive Computerised Assessment System testing otherwise known as InCAS. This testing gave us valuable standardised baseline data for students in Pre-primary to Year 6. In all there are several key areas that the testing focuses on: Picture Vocabulary, Non-Verbal, Word Recognition, Word Decoding, Comprehension, Spelling, Mental Arithmetic, General Maths and Attitudes to School, Maths and Reading. The interesting aspect of this programme is that we start students at their chronological age and they complete tasks and questions that actually change becoming more difficult or easier according to student responses. By the end of each test the student has their results presented in the actual chronological age they are working at. This then becomes a powerful assessment tool complimenting other assessments such as On-Entry testing, NAPLAN and other curriculum based assessments. Teachers will be available during Term Four to discuss these results with parents and carers.

Athletics Season

As you are aware Athletics season is fast approaching with the school participating in three carnivals this term; The Warperup Sports Day, The South Lakes Carnival at Broomehill and the Fitzgerald Carnival at Boxwood Hill. In order to prepare for these students have been practising new team games in Daily Fitness and learning how to Scissor Kick for high jumping at the South Lakes Athletics Carnival.

Nominations must be lodged with the Returning Officer:

at any time during the above period by arrangement; or

between 2:00pm and 4:00pm Thursday, 14 September 2017 (close of nominations) at the Shire of Gnowangerup, 28 Yougenup Road, GNOWANGERUP.

Nominations Requirements

Candidates are required to lodge with the Returning Officer:

- a completed nomination in the prescribed form, signed and witnessed. (This form is available from the Returning Officer, the Western Australian Electoral Commission or the Shire of Gnowangerup);
- a single A4 page profile containing not more than 150 words of information about the candidate;
- a nomination deposit of \$80 (cash, bank cheque or postal order); and
- a recent passport-sized photograph (optional).

The Commission has developed an online system called Nomination Builder to assist candidates to complete their nomination form which includes the candidate profile. This is the preferred method of completing the nomination form and profile for elections conducted by the Commission. Candidates complete their nomination details and profile, print the completed form which has a reference number allocated and lodge it with the Returning Officer. The nomination builder can be accessed at elections.wa.gov.au

Where an agent lodges a nomination on a candidate's behalf, it must be in the prescribed form with a written authorisation signed by the candidate.

The documents may be hand delivered, posted or faxed to the Returning Officer and must be received by the close of nominations.

SHIRE OF GNOWANGERUP

ADJUSTMENTS TO SHIRE OF GNOWANGERUP 2017/18 BUDGET

The WA Local Government Grants Commission advised in August 2017 that the final Financial Assistance Grants (FAGs) cash allocation to Western Australia is lower than originally advised by the Commonwealth in the May estimates. This is primarily as a result of new Census data becoming available in June.

The net result to the Shire is shown below:

General Purpose Component

Budgeted: \$398,080
New Figure: \$339,684
Budget Amendment: \$58,396

In addition, Main Roads WA has also advised that, due to State Government budget constraints, it has reduced its annual **road preservation grant** to the Shire as follows:

Roads Component

Budgeted: \$272,715
New Figure: \$272,858
Budget Amendment: (\$143)

Budgeted \$142,735
New Figure \$83,729
Budget Amendment: \$59,006

Overall Adjustment Required

\$58,396
(\$143)
\$58,253 budget shortfall

It is less than ideal that the State and Federal Governments seem unable to adhere to the estimates they provide to Local Government.

In summary, the Shire's budget position has been weakened by the amount of \$117,259. Due to previous good financial management, however, it is anticipated that the Shire will be able to make up this shortfall without a reduction in services, from a combination of a decrease in budgeted transfers to reserve and from end of financial year adjustments. Council is mindful of the current economic climate and, due to the aforementioned financial management, was able to limit the overall rate increase for 2017/2018 to 3.5%, rather than the 6% stated in its Long Term Financial Plan.
