## Shire residents invited to Weed Management field day

Residents of the Shire of Gnowangerup are invited to a Weeds Management field day on Thursday August 11<sup>th</sup>. The field day will be held from 9-11am at Michael and Sue Lance's property on the Tambellup road to tie in with Weed Smart Week. Laura Page, Trials Coordinator for North Stirlings Pallinup Natural Resources, says the aim of the field day is to assist landholders and residents to correctly identify and manage weeds as part of the project *Emerging Weeds and their Management in the North Stirlings Pallinup*.

"Weeds that are sharp or poisonous can be a problem in recreational areas and home gardens. Weeds can also compete with agricultural plants to reduce yields of crops and pastures, and they compete with native plants for water and nutrients. By becoming aware of the appearance and control of specific weeds, Shire of Gnowangerup residents can help reduce the impact of weeds, including Weeds of National Significance and WA Declared Weeds."

"The Department of Agriculture and Food has recently released the mobile device app MyWeedWatcher and we are encouraging residents to use this app to identify and learn about weeds. The app is particularly useful to improve surveillance of high priority declared weeds, such as skeleton weed and bedstraw." DAFWA staff will be on hand at the field day to discuss the app and answer any questions about weeds management.

## Ongerup Roadhouse update

Pallinup Pastoral PTY LTD wishes to advise that the settlement on their purchase of the Ongerup Roadhouse premises was finalised on 3.8.2016. We are now in the position of being able to proceed with setting up a new 24 hour credit card, fuel facility and hopefully finding a lessee to take on the running of a full roadhouse/Café operation.

We are happy to report that we have had expressions of interest from several parties interested in taking on the lease and running of the whole roadhouse operation. Negotiations are continuing with these parties and there is a very good chance that we could have a fully functional roadhouse/café prior to Christmas. Although Pallinup Pastoral had sufficient capital on hand to fund the purchase of the Roadhouse premises, we still require extra capital to fund the purchase of the card-fuel infrastructure and also some improvements are required inside the buildings. Whilst we are prepared to obtain a bank loan to raise the extra funds required if necessary, it would be much preferred if we could raise some of the extra capital from local sources. To this end we are still looking for new or past shareholders who may be in a position to purchase units in the Pallinup Pastoral Trust. We also welcome any other contributions that community members wish to make. We are happy to accept in the form of cash and /or produce. In the past unit holders in the Pallinup trust, have had good return on their investment.

We believe that the Ongerup roadhouse is an integral and essential facility for the future health of our town. The provision of fuel, takeaway food and sit down meals, is needed, not only for the local towns people, but also for the passing tourist trade, contract truckies and seasonal farm workers at certain times of the year.

The Shire of Gnowangerup is seeking Expressions of Interest from enthusiastic and motivated people to join the Community Services Team as a **Lifeguard / Club Development Officer**.

Our Community Services Unit is responsible for a broad range of social, cultural and community service provision including sport and recreational services. The successful applicant will be responsible for supporting the operations of the new Gnowangerup Community Swimming Pool Facility as well as undertaking the duties of Club Development Officer.

The Lifeguard / Club Development Officer position will consist of 15 hours per week over 1- 2 days and backfill for the Pool Manager during periods of leave. This position is a year-round position that will also require the successful applicant to undertake sport and recreation development activities as Club Development Officer.

There is also the possibility of additional hours being offered to the right applicant to provide operational support for the co-located Gnowangerup Sporting Complex however this will be by negotiation.

The successful applicant will be required to undertake training (funded by the Shire) or have an existing Bronze Medallion, Lifeguard and/or Pool Operations qualifications.
