Ongerup Primary School – What are we up to now!

Greetings! Welcome to 2017 the year that is!

This year the school is entering into two main projects:

The School Garden Project

As an integral part of the Design and Technology course we have commenced work on the re-vamp and upgrade of the school vegetable garden. Phase One - looks at the vegetable garden and Phase Two – the establishment of a mini orchard.

The aim of the project is to:

- Involve the whole school working together on collaborative project***
- Utilise sustainable resources to establish a quality organic produce, such as - rain water, manures, compost, mulch, worm castings and recycled waste and materials***
- Introduce students to a wide range of gardening skills and techniques including; composting, worm farming, propagating, establishing garden beds, crop rotation, basic garden hand tool use, vermin and pest control, soil testing and plant identification***

Utilise produce in cooking tasks and distribute excess produce within the community.

How can you help?

The school is looking for donations of manures - sheep, cow or pig if possible, whether it be by the bag, trailer or truck load. Just give me a call at school on 9828 2033.

Positive Behaviour Support – PBS

As touched on last year we plan to implement and embed the PBS framework into the fabric of our school community. This is a wonderful initiative that looks at a proactive and positive behavioural approach to the setting up of structures conducive to a warm and safe learning environment where all students feel a strong sense belonging. The process works consultatively and collaboratively involving input from all major stakeholders- the local community, parents, students and staff. It will be tailored to suit the wants and needs of our unique community here in Ongerup.

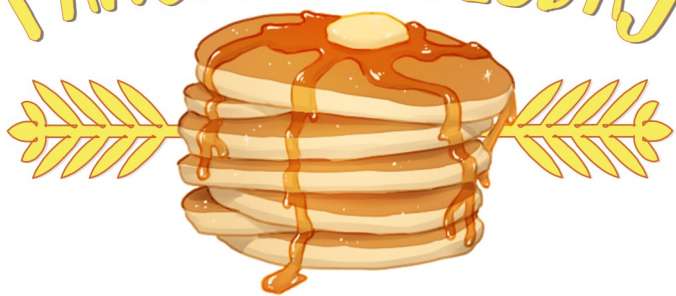
