Third Young Farmer Tour a Great Success

A national conference for young people in agriculture, Scarborough Beach, Sunday session, ten pin bowling, Ausplow factory tour, new friendships and networking groups, what more could you want from a North Stirlings Pallinup Natural Resources Young Farmer Tour?

On the way we collected 18 keen participants—ten in Borden, four in Gnowangerup, one in Katanning and met another three in Perth. On our arrival in Scarborough after a few dodgy bus games we enjoyed a 'getting to know you' Sunday session at Matisse Beach Club, ready for the beginning of Innovation Generation on Monday morning. Innovation Generation is an annual conference aimed at 18-35 year old agricultural professionals, held in a different venue around Australia every year. Traditionally hosted by GrainGrowers, this year it was co-hosted by the former WA Young-Farmers group, AgConnectWA.

The conference received around 160 registrations from all over

Australia, so we had a lot to learn and lots of new faces and networking opportunities. The third morning of the conference gave the opportunity to attend a tour of Wellards, CBH or a ProductionWise course. Our group was split across the three and they were enjoyed by everyone. In between two big days of presentations, there was lots of time to

socialise. In addition to events organised as part of Innovation Generation, our group enjoyed a lunch sponsored by Precision Soiltech at Clancy's Fish Pub on City Beach, with a presentation by Technical Manager and new AgConnect President Wes Lefroy.

We then went on to an afternoon of ten pin bowling, with some fierce competition resulting in Brandon Wise and Ethan Caldwell taking out the top two spots and winning a Precision Soiltech beanie each. The afternoon was partially sponsored by Ratten & Slater, so some (slightly questionable) farming-themed names were chosen to represent our groups.

On Thursday it was goodbye to Scarborough and on to Naval Base to the Ausplow factory. Ausplow was a great way to end Young Farmer Tour 2016—we loved seeing the same products manufactured in WA from start to finish, that we have seen working in the paddocks.

After 5 days, 4 nights, 1310 km, a substantial number of beers and lots of laughs, we headed back to Borden for a debrief at the pub to reflect on what a ripper time we'd had! GrainGrowers have announced that Innovation Generation will be held next year in Adelaide—watch this space for Young Farmer Tour 2017.
