




ONGERUP BOWLING CLUB ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

<u>Beans - broad beans, fava beans</u>	Plant in garden.	Harvest from October.
<u>Cabbage</u>	Plant out (transplant) seedlings.	Harvest from August.
<u>Garlic</u>	Plant in garden.	Harvest from November.
<u>Kale</u>	Plant out (transplant) seedlings.	Harvest from August.
<u>Lettuce</u>	Plant in garden.	Harvest from August.
<u>Mustard greens</u> (also <i>gai choy</i>)	Plant in garden.	Harvest from August.
<u>Onion</u>	Plant in garden.	Harvest from December.
<u>Peas</u>	Plant in garden.	Harvest from September.
<u>Radish</u>	Plant in garden.	Harvest from August.
<u>Snow Peas</u> (also <i>Sugar Peas, Mangetout, Chinese Peas</i>)	Plant in garden.	Harvest from October.
<u>Strawberries (from seeds)</u>	Start undercover in seed trays and plant out in 4-6 weeks.	Harvest from 12 months.
<u>Strawberry Plants</u>	Plant in garden.	Harvest from October.
