Jane Harper's debut novel

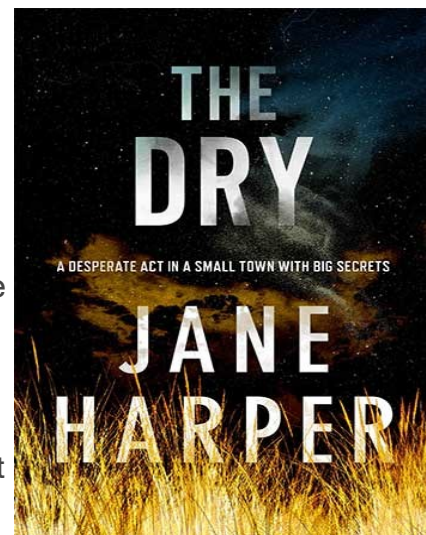

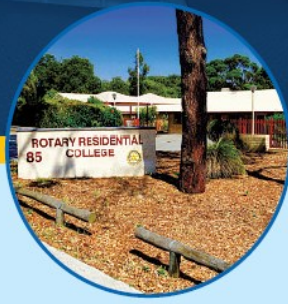

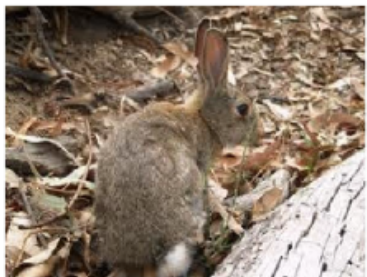
