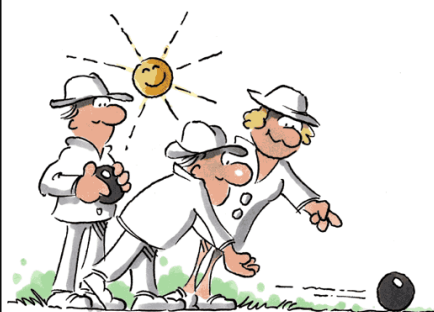

Well the term is drawing closer to end while the football is firing up!

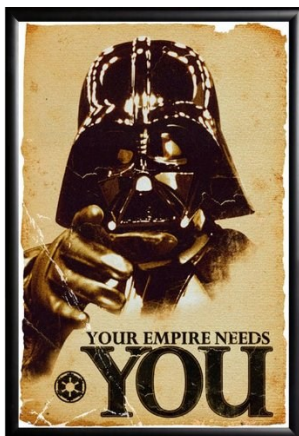
