There have been some exciting discoveries - a pygmy possum, and two frog species. One species, the white footed trilling frog, spend a lot of time in their underground burrows and breed after rain... Also caught in traps have been the expected spiders and insects which are all exciting, too. There definitely is plenty of life in the undergrowth!

There has been Malleefowl mound activity within the aviaries. One adult pair have been mounding quite happily and we will know in the next few months if she has been laying eggs. The juvenile mob in the large aviary are practising their scratching and digging skills and have the existing mound looking like they are getting the idea but at the wrong time of the year!

We had a bit of excitement last week when Graeme Sav bought up what we thought was a baby Malleefowl, he had caught in his tyre shed. Vicky dashed our hopes by identifying her as a stubble quail and she is now happily back in the wild.
