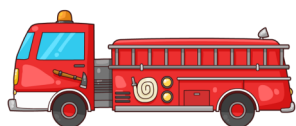

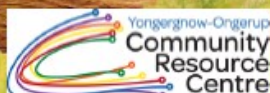
Nannygoat Junction offers Artisan Goat Cheese fresh from their farm that backs onto West Cape Howe at Lowlands on the Albany/Denmark border.

Messina and Saline Pastures

Field Walk

Despite the wintery conditions , North Stirlings Pallinup Natural Resources held a successful field walk near the intersection of Tie Line Road and Mindarabin Road, Mindarabin., on Monday 19th September.



The new annual legume **messina** has grown on even the most saline conditions at the site, up to 400 mS/m.

The participants remarked on the large number of nodules on the **messina** plant. The selected 'special' rhizobia is salt-tolerant.



Balansa clover and lucerne as well as messina have been strategically seeded according to soil type at the site. The legumes will produce nitrogen to encourage growth of the tall wheatgrass , puccinellia and Italian ryegrass. We did not see any seedheads of sea barley grass, which previously dominated the site.

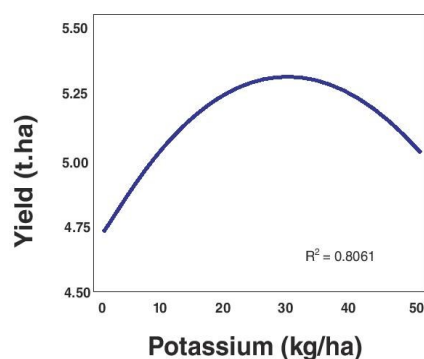

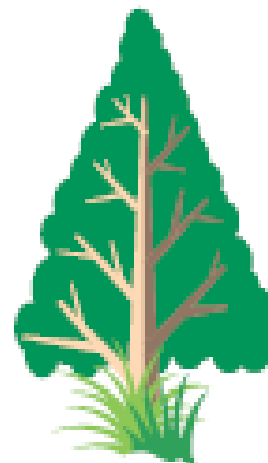
