## PUBLIC NOTICE BULK RUBBISH COLLECTION

The Shire will provide a bulk rubbish collection for households on the following dates:

**Gnowangerup - Monday 4<sup>th</sup> December 2017**

**Borden & Ongerup – Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> December 2017**

Items for collection (refer to the table below) must be placed in a neat, tidy pile on the verge **no earlier than Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> November 2017**. All items not collected by Council. Must be removed from your verge immediately.

Household furniture.	Household rubbish.
White goods: stoves, dishwashers, washing machines, dryers etc.	Building waste: bricks, rubble, sand, cement Asbestos cement products
Fridges & Freezers: doors MUST be removed before placing on verge	Gas cylinders
Air conditioning units	Car parts: tyres, batteries etc.
General junk: small electrical goods, carpet, lino, Mattresses etc. <i>NOTE: all electrical items MUST have their plugs removed</i>	Household hazardous waste: oil, pesticides, solvents, chemicals, paint, sprays
E-Waste: computers, televisions, DVD players	Glass: windows, doors, sheet glass, shower screens
Unwanted pine	Flammable products
Green waste: to be sorted & separated from other items	Shed/garage roller doors longer than 1.5m

*PLEASE NOTE: Council will not collect goods outside any of the following: industrial or commercial business, empty/vacant lots, rights of way, lanes, reserves or parks.*

## Public Notice

Recently the mature sugar gum near the Shire Administration Office dropped a very large branch across the car park. Due to public safety concerns the Shire commissioned the Arbor Centre in Perth, a professional Arboricultural Company, to provide an arboricultural assessment to report on the condition of the tree and provide guidance in determining the appropriate course of action for the future.

The report identified that this mature tree has issues due to its pruning history which has caused poorly attached branches and recommended that to keep the tree and reduce safety issues for the public a variety of remedial are required. This includes remedial canopy pruning, a fall arrest system and ongoing professional monitoring. The cost of the recommended remedial work is very expensive and there is no real guarantee that another branch will not fall.

The Shire Council understands the aesthetic value of this tree however public safety is the priority so the decision to remove the tree is seen as the safest option.

The tree will be professionally removed in the near future.
