

Community Financial Assistant Grants 2018/19

Community Groups within the Shire of Gnowangerup are now invited to apply for the Community Financial Assistance Grants (CFAG) Program. There are three categories of funding available for projects taking place in 18/19 financial year.

1. Quick Grants - for applications up to \$500.00, primarily for volunteer support.
2. Community Grants - for applications from \$501.00 - \$5,000.00 aimed at supporting community groups with small capital projects, events, projects etc.
3. Special Requests Community Grants - for applications from \$5000.00 - \$20,000.00 aimed at supporting community groups with large capital projects, events, projects etc. The purpose of the grant is not to fund operating costs

Comprehensive guidelines, application forms and acquittal statements for each category can be found on our website under "Public Notices" or by contacting the Shire Office on 9827 1007.

Requests for operational funding, works-in-kind or reimbursement for expenses prior to the 2018/2019 financial year will no longer be accepted under the guidelines. Furthermore, this is now the only pathway to request Council contribution for partnership funding for any project throughout the year. Please consider all events, projects or infrastructure your community group is planning for the 2018/19 year carefully, as applications will only be open once per year.

If your community group is interested in applying for assistance under any of the grant categories, please make contact with the Shire of Gnowangerup at cfo@gnowangerup.wa.gov.au or 98271007 to discuss your idea.

Step 1 - Contact the Shire of Gnowangerup to discuss your project idea on 9827 1007
Step 2 - Complete the respective Grant Application Form.
Step 3 - Submit the application form by 4:00pm 11/5/2018.
Step 4 - Applications are assessed; Council approves suitable applicants at the Annual Budget meeting.
Step 5 - Applicants are notified in writing in August 2018.

The Shire of Gnowangerup will be holding a Grant Writing Workshop later in the year and will advise shortly of the dates. We strongly recommend Community Groups to attend this workshop to assist with grant application submission.

We look forward to supporting our fantastic community organisations in 2018/2019.

SHIRE WATER SOURCES IN GNOWANGERUP

There have been a couple of recent incidents where members of the community have taken water illegally from one or another of the water sources in the Gnowangerup town site.

It is timely, therefore, to remind everyone that:

- The dam next to the bowling club is for the sole use of the club;
- The dam to the west of the bowling club dam has a standpipe and is available for emergency personal use of people living outside the town site who do not have access to scheme water. It is not for the use of people or businesses located in town; and
- The metered standpipe opposite the Shire Depot uses scheme water and is available to all community members, individuals and businesses alike. Access cards are available from the Shire Office.

Any unauthorised use is stealing and could lead to prosecution.



VERTICAL FARM REAL ESTATE

Friday 16th March 2018

Key constraints for farming in the NSPNR region are soil salinity and low soil fertility. Areas not capable of producing break-even yields are considered 'marginal' and are not used for cropping. There is potential to regenerate these patches and have them contributing to a whole-farm system in a sustainable manner.

How different forage species can work together for the benefit of the livestock, soil health and the sustainable profit for farm businesses will be discussed at the field visit. This is proudly presented by Dean Revell, Revell Science and North Stirlings Pallinup Natural Resources. This project is made possible by funding from the Western Australian Government's State Natural Resource Management Program supported by Royalties for Regions.
