

The dishes kept on coming out and the servings were plentiful, with 4 people to a 'platter'. Starting with cold entrée's, an Israeli tradition, we then moved on to an array of main dishes. Much to the delight of staff, another tradition which Chef Riki insisted on was that the same plate would be used for the starters and the mains. The reason behind this is of

course, to keep all those wonderful flavours and tastes on the plate! Chef Riki also explained how taking a plate away in between courses actually breaks the spirit of the table and leaves the diner feeling a sense of incompleteness. By keeping the same plate there is no 'breaking off' between diners and they can continue to connect through the food which is in front of them. Once finished with the savoury dishes we were treated to a trio of desserts and fresh mint tea, a lovely finish to a wonderful meal.

Chef Riki's talk in between courses, explaining cultural traditions and her cooking methods, really made the event a personal, informative and a friendly experience. Her traditions of dinner time being a time to connect and a time to share, whilst also being loud and fun seemed very fitting for not only those diners with family, but also those who like to entertain guests.

It was agreed by all attendees that this year's Taste Great Southern was perhaps our best. Chef Riki and Heni were an absolute pleasure to work with, the food was exquisite and the portion sizes were more than enough!

The spices from Riki's Moroccan inspired spice range were also a hit and they almost sold out between the day of the lunch, and the hour's talk she gave at the centre the night before.

We sincerely hope we have the pleasure of working with Chef Riki and Heni again and our involvement in the Taste Great Southern event produces more great long table lunch's, just as this one did!




