

## THE KEEP WATCH TODDLER DROWNING PREVENTION PROGRAM IS NOW AVAILABLE IN THE GREAT SOUTHERN!

### What is the Keep Watch program?

Keep Watch is a health promotion program coordinated by the Royal Life Saving Society WA (RLSSWA). The program educates parents and carers of young children about toddler drowning risks and prevention strategies.

Drowning is the leading cause of preventable death in children under 5 years of age in Australia. On average 4 toddlers drown each year in WA and another 40 are hospitalised across the state. Keep Watch aims to prevent these tragic incidents by reminding parents of the things they can do around their homes to keep their kids safe.

### What services are on offer in the Great Southern?

RLSSWA is generously supported by the Western Australian Department of Health and BHP to provide toddler drowning prevention education across WA. We now have a staff member available in the Great Southern to deliver program activities on an ongoing basis. The program targets parents and health & community workers.

#### Parent presentations

Available for family centres, playgroups and new mums groups. This session is for parents and carers who would like to learn more about why toddlers are at risk of drowning and how to keep them safe around water. A demonstration of child CPR can also be provided if requested. This presentation runs for 30 minutes (presentation only) to one hour (presentation and CPR demonstration) and is free of charge.

#### Events

We are looking for events in the Great Southern where Keep Watch can be promoted. This includes any local parenting, family or safety-focused events/expos.

#### Heart Beat Club

A three hour basic CPR and first aid course suitable for parents of young kids. The course covers child and infant CPR and first aid for injuries such as burns and scalds, choking and poisoning. The course costs \$20 per person.


