ABOUT AusCHEM ACCREDITATION

Reaccreditation- 1 Day Course:

Participants must have completed Risk Management in Pesticide Use (or an equivalent qualification).

Chemical users who have let their accreditation lapse for over 10 years are not eligible to attend re-accreditation programmes and will need to re-take Risk Management in Pesticide Use

AusChem Accreditation: Risk Management in Pesticide Use- 2 Day Course

Participants will learn on a practical level how to improve their integrated pest management programmes, to better choose the right chemical for the job and to apply it more accurately. 

The Shire of Gnowangerup are seeking expressions of interest from person/groups interested in purchasing Lot 517 Carpenter/Vaux Streets, Ongerup.

Lot 517 is 1,285m² in area and was previously the Ongerup Police Station and Courthouse. The property has access to electricity, water supply, bottled gas and telecommunications.

The buildings are serviced with an onsite effluent disposal system.

The property is sold in an “as is” condition. The property is presently being rezoned to Residential by the Shire to facilitate its future redevelopment for housing purposes.

The market value established in the valuation report prepared by the Shire in June 2017 was \$50,000.
