As we are approaching the 2018 revegetation and fencing season NSPNR highlights the reasons why we have 42 ha planned revegetation and 16.6km fencing.

North Stirlings Pallinup Natural Resources (NSPNR) covers a total area of 541, 629 ha and is the predominant Landcare and natural resource management group operating within the Shire of Gnowangerup.

The area contains at risk fauna including Red-tailed Phascogales,

Carnaby's Cockatoos, Malleefowl and Black-gloved Wallabies, to name a

few. Revegetating these waterways and fragmented landscapes not only provides key linkages for native fauna to safely migrate forage and live, it also stabilises degraded waterways that are susceptible to rainfall and wind events.

These activities promote recovery of existing vegetation as no action will result in creating further unusable areas of land.

Where needed salt tolerant ground covers, rushes, middle and upper storey plants are used to accelerate the process of rehabilitation and provide immediate cover to exposed soil.

We consistently see first-hand in our area how fencing and revegetation leads to rehabilitation and diversity of flora and fauna.

The outcome of this project is to restore waterways through fencing and revegetation in the North Stirlings Pallinup area.

This project is supported by funding from the Western Australian Government's State NRM Program, supported by Royalties for Regions.

ABOUT AUSCHEM ACCREDITATION

Reaccreditation- 1 Day Course:
Participants must have completed Risk Management in Pesticide Use (or an equivalent qualification). Chemical users who have let their accreditation lapse for over 10 years are not eligible to attend re-accreditation programmes and will need to re-take Risk Management in Pesticide Use

AusChem Accreditation: Risk Management in Pesticide Use- 2 Day Course
Participants will learn on a practical level how to improve their integrated pest management programmes, to better choose the right chemical for the job and to apply it more accurately. The course is designed for people who will be spraying chemicals without supervision. This is an accredited course and successful completion will lead to issuance of AusChem WA accreditation.


