Remembrance day 100 years

At 11 am on 11 November 1918 the guns on the Western Front fell silent after more than four years of continuous warfare. The allied armies had driven the German invaders back, having inflicted heavy defeats upon them over the preceding four months. In November the Germans called for an armistice (suspension of fighting) in order to secure a peace settlement. They accepted allied terms that amounted to unconditional surrender.

LEST WE FORGET: 1914 -1918 WW1

These are the names on the Ongerup Hall Honour Board of the men who enlisted from Ongerup.

ATHOL JONES: came from Guildford in 1911 and settled 4 miles East of Ongerup on the Needilup Road. He was married and had two children. Mr. Jones was the local blacksmith, He enlisted in 1916 and did not return to Ongerup.

DUNCAN WALKER: with his father Robert and brothers Robert and George purchased land in 1911 on the corner of the Pingrup and Old Ongerup Roads. Duncan joined the forces in World War 1 and worked in Perth on his return.

J. MESNEY: Moved on to a block East of Stan Vaux¹s original holding. He joined the forces in WW1 and didn't return. Mr. Vaux purchased the block which has a soak on it.

F. GRIMSTER: Bought a block east of Stan Vaux, joined up in WW1 and didn't return. The land was later purchased by D. Houston. Grimster Road runs east from the Pingrup Rd, near Kingsley Vaux's property

W. PALMER: Walter and his two brothers came to Ongerup from U.K. in 1912. The block they acquired was north east of town. Later they moved to a block nearer to the town, on Magner road. Walter enlisted in WW1 and didn't return. The two brothers left the district in 1938.

F.C. WEST: Mr. West, an Englishman, purchased land from Miss Sophia Jane Walker of England through Mr. Arthur Rohrs of Maileup, Broomehill in 1911. Another piece of land was purchased from a Mr. W. Johnson of Bally Bally in 1913. During the First WW Mr. West returned to England and came back to his property with his bride Violet in 1919.

Mr. West was awarded first prize in 1948/49 in a 50 acre crop competition conducted by the W.A. Flour Mill owners association. Mr. West died in 1959.

Jon Price, past resident of Ongerup is a relative of Mr. West.

Some years back I tried to add more to these men so they weren't just names on a wall & would've liked to collect more of their story, but this is all I could collect. If anyone could help I would add it to the history collection at the Museum. So with the 100yr celebration of Remembrance Day maybe I could add to this.

Malleefowl Monitor Training

Monitoring Malleefowl will not in itself save them, but it is an extremely important tool in understanding how the species is going. If there was a sudden crash in any population, we need to be aware of the situation ASAP. Annual monitoring is also essential if we are to understand long-term trends that may vary due to many factors including climate change.

Malleefowl exist right across Australia so we need to ensure everyone is monitoring in the same way. Over many years we have developed a method of monitoring Malleefowl that doesn't upset the birds, doesn't place more demands on the people doing the work than necessary and is scientifically robust.

We have developed a system that uses modern technology and is easy to use. Volunteers are supplied with smartphones with our own monitoring app installed.

At the training, we will show you how to use the equipment and then travel to a site where we will visit several mounds and go through the monitoring methodology.

Apart from learning how to take part in this important Citizen Science project, you will be mixing with lots of very knowledgeable Malleefowl people.

- Everyone gets to play with the app on our smartphones and learn how we use them in the field
- We will use GPS to navigate to Malleefowl mounds to record the data for each round
- At the mounds we will practice the best monitoring methods and how to use the smartphones

Sunday 11th

- For those that get bitten by the monitoring bug we will be going to other sites to continue monitoring

Note that we will be walking through sometimes heavy bush. Ensure that you have good walking shoes and clothing to protect yourself from scratching and sun...sounds fun doesn't it?
