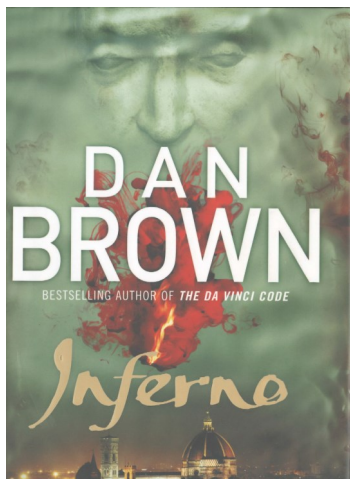

LIBRARY NEWS FROM YONGERGNOW-CRC

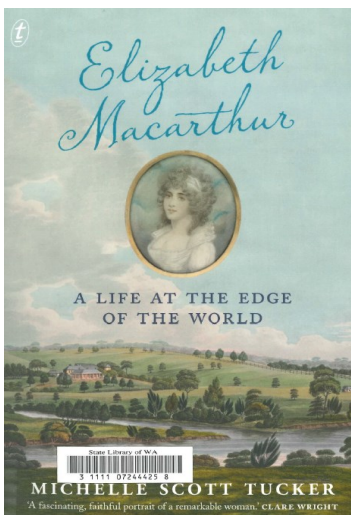
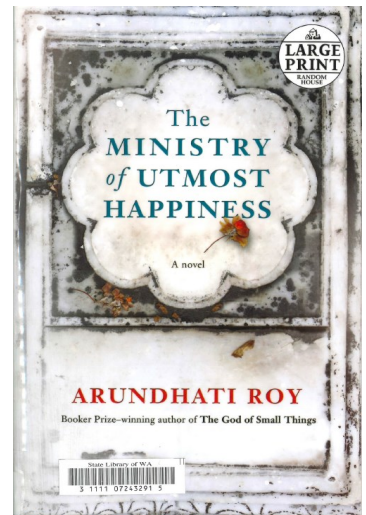
Here's a taste of new books just into the library.
