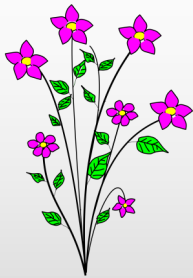

The Protective Behaviours program was developed
in the 1970's and is now a mandatory part of the
Australian and Western Australian curriculum.

- It aims to enhance problem solving and communication skills of children
- It encourages children to identify situations that are unsafe or potentially unsafe, and to develop practical strategies to counter these situations in order to preserve their physical and emotional safety.
- It focuses on addressing a wide range of personal safety issues perpetrated by known or unknown people, including being lost, bullying, abduction and all forms of abuse.

In this course for parents, we will look at strategies and resources that parents can be utilising at home to help build these very important skills into the lives of their children.

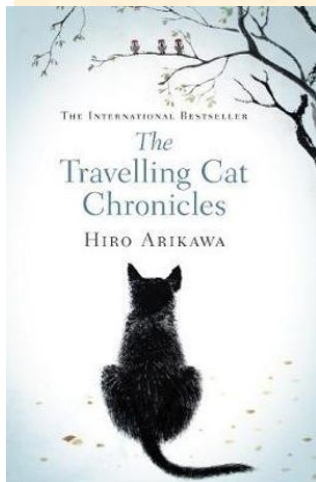

Two great reads from your local library

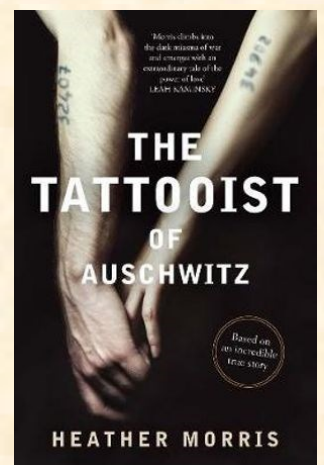
Your local library is open five days a week with a great selection of fiction and non fiction books, and dvd's. We can order in any special requests.



A quirky little book written from Nana the cat's perspective. Nana is a stray and happily sleeps on the bonnet of a van every day but when misfortune strikes he is rescued by the van's owner Satoru and happily settles into life as a domestic cat. Tragically Satoru must find Nana a new home, and they travel the Japanese countryside visiting old friends, none of whom Nana feels could take care of him.

This is a lovely easy reading book to curl up with for a couple of hours on the couch.

Based on a true story this book follows the journey of Lale who is sent to Auschwitz in 1945. He is lucky to be given the privileged job as a tattooist. Using his advantages to help his fellow prisoners, Lale meets Grita when he tattoos her arm and immediately falls in love. This is an uplifting story of love, brutality and hope set in the horrors of a concentration camp. A great read for those who like a bit heavier content in their books.
