*The Borden Group is seeking a cropping manager to oversee its 2019/2020 Community cropping program.*

The 40ha site, 5km north of the Borden townsite, has been generously donated to the Borden community over a number of years by A O'Meehan & Co. The Borden Group has managed the site for the past two cropping seasons. Previous to this it was managed by the Borden Football Club. So far all funds raised by The Borden Group through the cropping program have been used to pay off a large portion of the purchase price of the Borden Community Bus, which is managed by the group, and to construct a shed for the bus. We hope any profit from this year's crop will allow us to pay off the remainder of the bus loan. 
