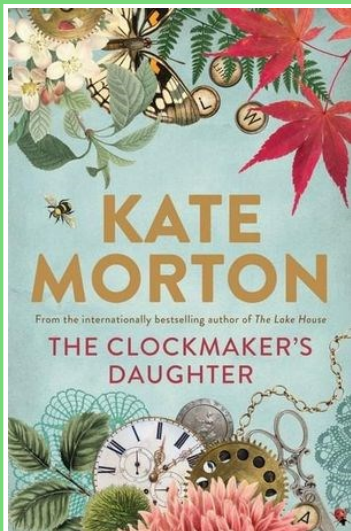

ONGERUP BOOK CLUB REVIEW



Last week we gathered at Leanne's house to review her book choice "The Clockmakers Daughter" by Kate Morton.

In the summer of 1862, a group of young artists led by the passionate and talented Edward Radcliffe descend upon Birchwood Manor on the banks of the Upper Thames to spend a secluded summer in a haze of inspiration and creativity. But by the time their stay is over, one woman has been shot dead, another has disappeared and a priceless heirloom is missing. Over one hundred and fifty years later, a young London archivist, Elodie Winslow, uncovers a leather satchel containing two seemingly unrelated items and the mystery of Birchwood Manor unfolds as Elodie researches the items and her connection through her childhood stories. Told in multiple voices across time, this is a story of murder, mystery and thievery,

of art, love and loss.

The 8 book clubbers' opinions ranged from 'couldn't read past the first chapter to very engaging to the last page'. Chapters were from different characters and when the ghost was talking that was hard to catch where it fitted in. Some felt it was very confusing but slowly sorted out the relationships between the eras and the present day. Lots of discussion about where the mysterious blue diamond was passed on and how the ghost came to be. Mel solved some of the mysteries as she had listened to the audio book and read the real book - such dedication when she rated it poorly!
