OCD PRESIDENTS REPORT FOR 2019

I would like to thank everyone who has attended OCD meetings or helped out with any OCD projects. I would like to make special mention of Roz Thompson for continuing with the position as OCD Secretary and Sandy Vaux for her ever enduring and seemingly undying enthusiasm for Ongerup as OCD Treasurer as well as all of her many other hats.

I would also like to thank Alan Richardson of Cadallelup Farms and the Education Department for giving the OCD the opportunity to share crop part of the Gnowangerup Ag School and the generous financial return it produced. We are looking forward to hopefully repeating the success of the project in the coming season.

The OCD has continued to financially support Yongergnow to assist paying in wages. Yongergnow continues to provide a return on our investment in providing a venue for the CRC, the Library and a great location to host many enjoyable events. We have also assisted in promoting Ongerup as a tourist destination by advertising in conjunction with Yongergnow and the CRC in tourism brochures, websites and maps.

Both OCD houses are currently rented and these continue to be a valuable asset to the community. We are planning to build two more 4x2 houses for rental. We are in a pool with other bodies, mainly local government councils who are working on the Great Southern Regional Housing project. The total project is worth about \$20M and when completed there will be about 50 dwellings for workers and retirees in the Great Southern. This project is 50% funded by the Federal Government. The OCD is looking at putting in 25% cash and inkind contributions and borrowing the remaining 25%. With this level of borrowing the rent should cover the payments resulting in zero on going cost to the OCD. I feel this is a fantastic opportunity to provide the community with 4x2 modern house to rent that can cater for larger families.

The Townscape Committee have continued with making Ongerup a more pleasant place to live with projects at the Cemetery, assisting the Shire with town gardens and artwork and generally keeping the town tidy. All of your efforts are appreciated.

Once again, I would like to thank everybody who have attended meetings throughout the year. The OCD represents the whole Ongerup Community and it is your organization for your benefit. The more people involved then the less work for each member so please lend a hand and the whole community will benefit.
