



THE LOST MAN BY JANE HARPER.

Three brothers, one death, a fence line stretching to the horizon. Two brothers meet at the border of their vast cattle properties under the unrelenting sun of outback Queensland. They are at the stockman's grave, a landmark so old, no one can remember who is buried there. But today, the scant shadow it casts was the last hope for their middle brother, Cameron. The Bright family's quiet existence is thrown into grief and anguish. Something had been troubling Cam. Did he lose hope and walk to his death? Because if he didn't, the isolation of the outback leaves few suspects.

The Lost man was Sandy's choice, Roz found out that she would be on school camp when her turn was so Sandy picked up the baton, Thank you Sandy.

Monday night saw a depleted book club with only 7 of us meet at Sandy's. I had unfortunately missed last month's so was looking forward to this month. We had all read the book and only one was not quite finished. The book was an easy read with the disturbing undercurrent of domestic violence running through the story. It had murder, family secrets and marriage break downs in the back drop of the harsh outback of Queensland station country.
