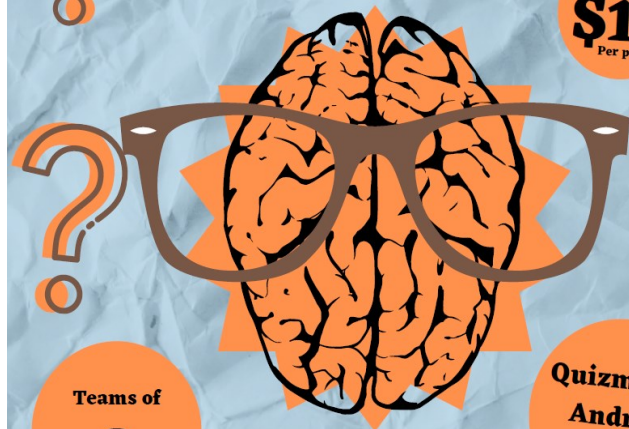

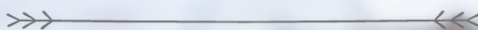

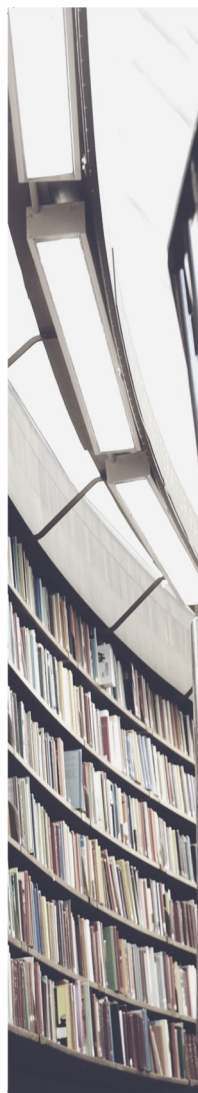
Position Vacant Tourism Traineeship Certificate II in Tourism
