




**INTENTION TO MAKE A VOLUNTEER BUSH FIRE BRIGADES
LOCAL LAW**

It is intended to make a Volunteer Bush Fire Brigades Local Law.

The purpose of the proposed local law is to provide for the appointment or election of a captain, a first lieutenant, a second lieutenant, and such additional lieutenants as may be necessary as officers of bush fire brigades in the district, and prescribe their respective duties.

The effect is that the appointment or election of a captain, a first lieutenant, a second lieutenant, and such additional lieutenants as may be necessary as officers of bush fire brigades in the district is prescribed, as are their respective duties.
