

## COORDINATOR A BOOST FOR REGIONAL VENUE

Borden Pavilion is welcoming a new era with the appointment of a paid coordinator at the Great Southern's premier regional function venue.

The part-time position has been taken up by 31-year-old Borden woman Pip Moir who has a solid professional background in marketing and journalism in Perth and Albany.

Ms Moir will be responsible for coordinating an increased profile for the modern facility, including driving growth in usage and hiring and negotiating marketing opportunities.

Borden Pavilion Committee Inc President David Bungey says it's an exciting new venture.

"The committee recognised a need to have a paid coordinator to bring some new life into the building so it can be used and enjoyed by not only our local community but people from all across the region."

Ms Moir says the local community has been enthusiastic in their support.

"I've already received some amazing feedback from locals as to how they want to see their pavilion used, so there are lots of ideas in the pipeline for 2019 and beyond."

Borden Pavilion is an ideal venue for events of any kind including small meetings, large conferences, concerts, parties and sporting activities.

120 kilometres north of Albany, Borden Pavilion is centrally located in the Gnowangerup Shire and in close proximity to the Stirling Range National Park.

The main function room is licensed to hold 400 people, with tables and seating for approximately 110 people. There is a large communal kitchen and bar area with a cool room. A courtyard with barbecue facilities adjoins the function room. The meeting room is able to seat up to 25 people. Creche facilities are also available.

The Borden Pavilion sporting complex consists of football and hockey ovals, as well as two multi-purpose courts, cricket practice nets and a recently refurbished bowling green.


