Risotto ai Porcini e Pancetta (\$ 18)

Traditional risotto with Porcini mushrooms and pancetta finished with Grana Padano



Grana Padano is a cheese made in the Po River Valley and has similar characteristics to Parmigiano Reggiano (a.k.a. real Parmesan)

Porcini are a very common variety of wild mushrooms throughout Europe. They have a nice strong aroma and a woody flavor

Pollo della Domenica (\$ 26)

Northern style chicken thighs (from Mount Barker Free Range chicken) served with cheesy polenta, roasted potatoes and salad



Pollo della Domenica means "Sunday Chicken". It is very traditional for Sunday lunch. Chicken pieces are slowly pan roasted with herbs and wine.



Polenta is simply boiled cornmeal and a common side to meat dishes as it absorbs the juices therefore the flavor of the meat

Lasagne paglia e fieno (\$ 22)

Lasagne alla bolognese made with home made fresh egg pasta and green pasta, traditional beef and pork ragu and ham finished with Grana Padano



"Paglia e fieno" (literally "straw" and "hay") is the combination of egg pasta (naturally yellow, the "straw") and green pasta (the "hay") in the same dish



Green pasta can be made with spinach, silver beets, chicory or herbs.


