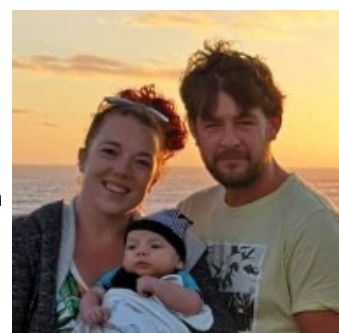

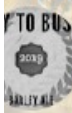

The latest data from Australian Institute of Health and Welfare (AIHW) reports one woman a week is killed from a current or former partner; and one man a month is killed due to domestic and family violence. In the first 6 weeks of 2018, nine women have been killed including two women in Western Australia.

The Women's Council is campaigning to have other local governments, refugees and domestic violence services across WA participate in placing benches to honour local victims and act as a visual reminder of the prevalence of domestic and family violence and its consequences within our communities.
