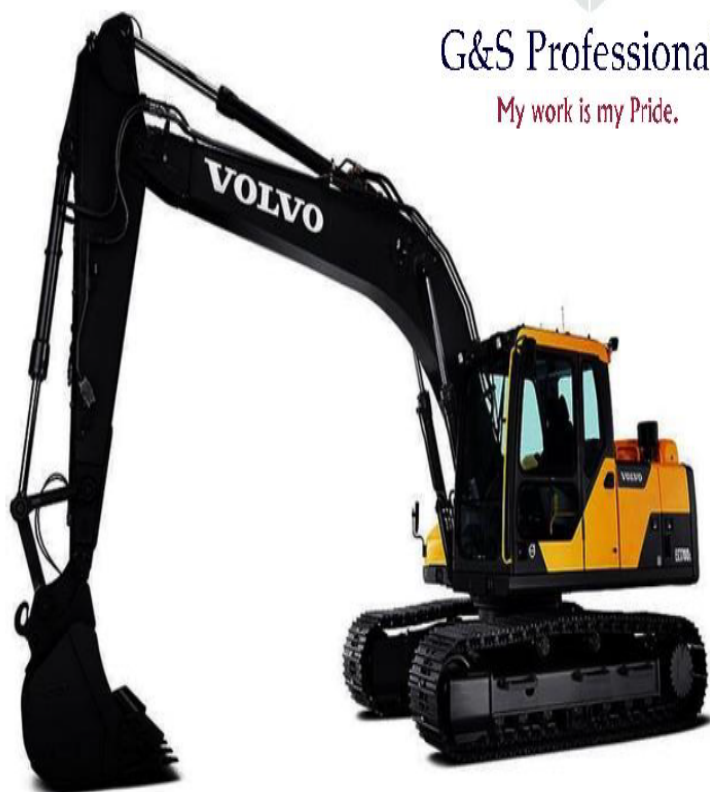
- What type of car seat is legal (and best) for children aged 0-6months, 6months - 4years and 4-7 years
