

ELECTION RESULTS AND ELECTION OF SHIRE PRESIDENT AND DEPUTY PRESIDENT



*The new and re-elected Councillors were sworn in by Philip O'Meehan JP.
Cr Fiona Gaze, Cr Mick Creagh, Cr Kate O'Keeffe, Cr Shelley Hmeljak and Philip O'Meehan JP*

Fiona Gaze, Shelley Hmeljak, Kate O'Keeffe and Mick Creagh have been elected to serve as Councillors for the Shire of Gnowangerup in the 2019 Ordinary Election.

Mick Creagh topped the count with 321 votes, followed by Fiona Gaze (293 votes), Kate O'Keeffe (275 votes) and Shelley Hmeljak (252 votes).

The Elected Members were officially sworn in by Justice of the Peace Philip O'Meehan at the Special Council Meeting on Wednesday, 23rd October 2019.

Councillor Fiona Gaze was duly elected by the Council to take on the Shire President role and Councillor Greg Stewart was voted in as Deputy President.

- Up coming Type 1 Child Car Restraint fitting Course and how they can get involved if they want to (might even be good for one of your staff so the CRC can offer this service to the community)




