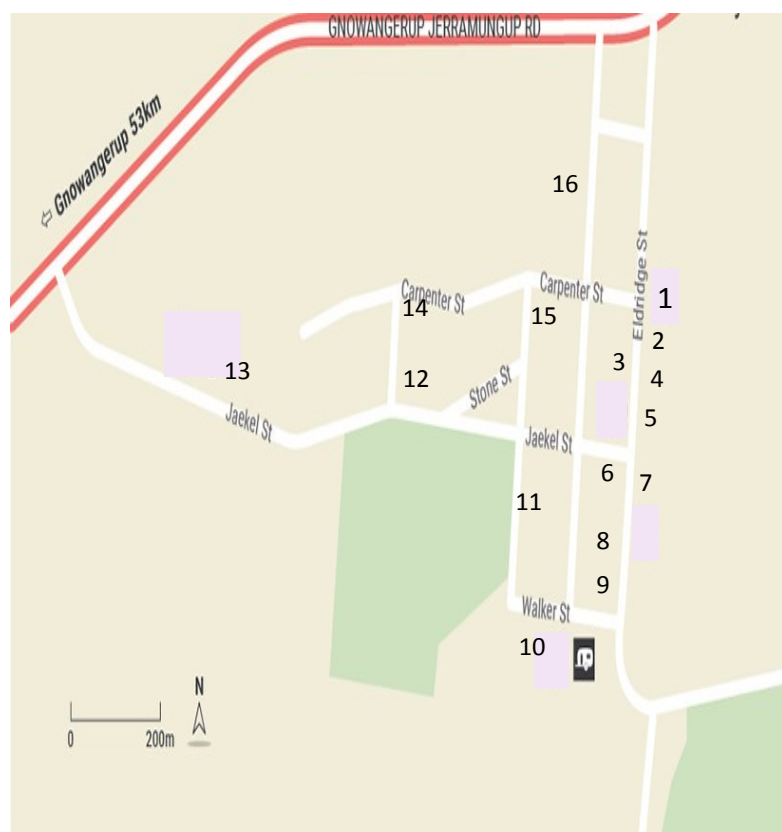

Have a walk around town and have a look at the SPRING ART TRAIL

Starting at Ongerup Tyres heading south and looking both sides of Eldridge Street :

1. Cottage garden junk sculpture and hut façade and early settlers garden—1 of 3 along the main street fashioned by creative artist Voytek and depicting different aspects of 100 years around Ongerup
2. Farming junk sculpture and Mediterranean plant garden—2 of 3
3. “Birds of Paradise” folk art pickets at old bank—Tim & Vicki’s house
4. Centenary metal banner commemorating Ongerup’s 100 years - started by John McDougall, Pingrup farmer/welder, and finished by Dave Taylor, blacksmith, woodworker and creative artist from Porongorups.
5. Kangaroo junk sculpture and native garden bed - 3 of 3
6. Corner shed verandah - Tracy has created some scrap metal birds and other arty pieces
7. Museum gate garden bed - sand bed planted with local native plants that won’t grow in the hard clay inside museum grounds
8. White shed with recycled garden beds made by John and Josie with an amazing array of plants and garden sculpture
9. Ed’s garden sculpture collection and colourful plantings, not to mention his colourful hippy car!
10. Caravan Park—Leanne and Steve have created a great looking entrance with large rocks and flower bed
11. Casa del Swalwell - Tracy has more creations made from recycled materials
12. Jenny’s collection of bird tea-towels in a colourful display along the fence
13. Yongergnow mixed collection of sculptures at entrance and artworks in gallery
14. Sheep with a growing fleece and willy wagtail with recycled sheep yard gates at Sandy’s duplex
15. Glenys and Graeme’s garden collection with various pot holders one being a toilet pedestal
16. Ongerup Primary School - collage of bird prints created by the students located at the School entrance

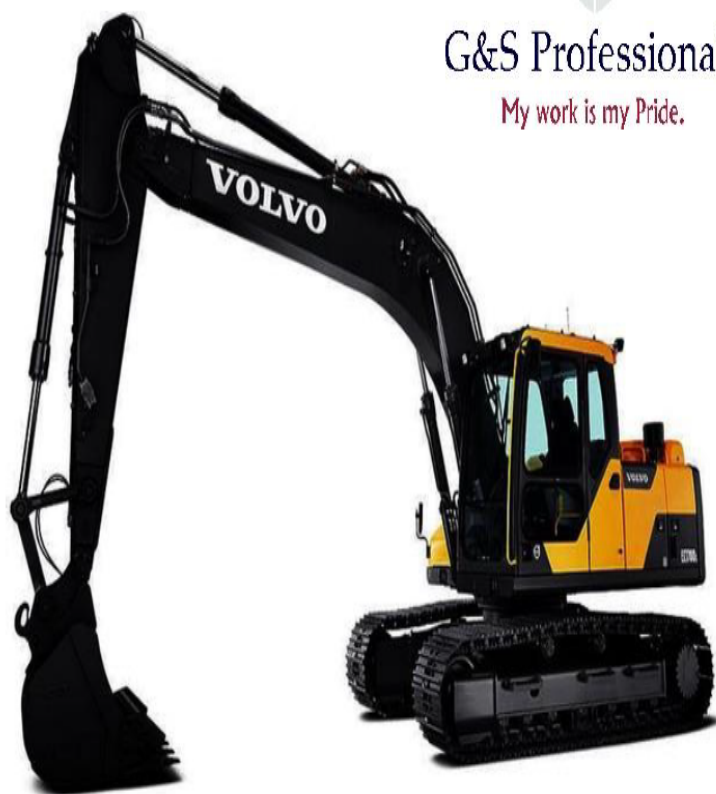

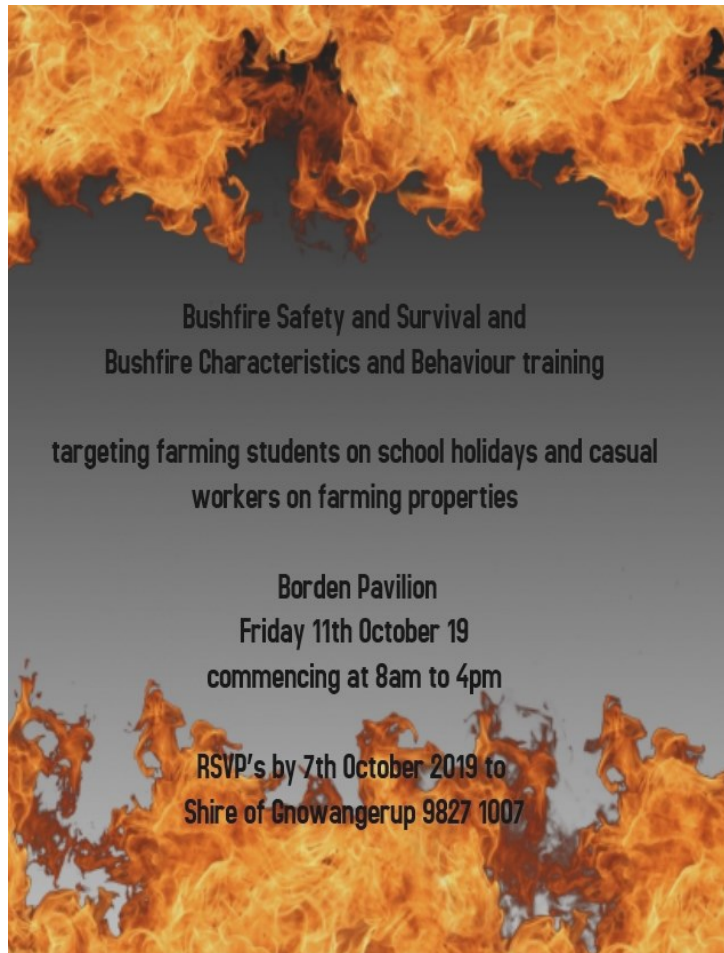

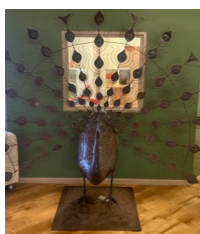
