

## What are we up to now!

Greetings all!

With the coming of Christmas all is full steam ahead with our annual End of Year Concert and Awards Night preparations. I cordially invite our local community to come in and be part of this wonderful event. This year our students are presenting "Suessical the Musical". The formalities commence at 6.30pm with our generous P&C providing a light supper around 8.30pm.



### Public School Review

All Western Australian public schools are reviewed every three years. The reviews give assurance that a school is operating effectively and delivering high quality education to its students.

The Public School Review process complements the school's existing self-assessment processes and gives feedback to support the principal and staff with their continuous improvement planning.

In our self-assessment we identified specific areas that could be improved. The Public School Review and resulting report confirmed our assessment and supports our intention to prioritise these aspects of our school improvement.

The review highlighted levels of effectiveness in a number of areas. However, we are yet to achieve the whole-school performance and progress we are seeking and continue to work towards this.

In particular, we are striving to implement school-wide improvement strategies, which continue to be informed by the rigorous analysis of data and other evidence available to us.

We have discussed our position with our School Council who are supportive and encouraging of the direction our school is taking in addressing these recommendations.

### Overcoming Challenges

Despite the challenges that 2019 has brought to the school our staff has worked extremely hard in the delivery of quality teaching and learning. Throughout the year we have continued to extend and enrich our curriculum with a number of wonderful camps, excursions, incursions and engaging learning experiences. We have undergone extensive renovations and are currently developing a specialised "STEAM Room" for the delivery of Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics.

We are well-resourced; and through High Priority Government funding we continue to upgrade and improve our school grounds and buildings. We are also busily preparing for 2020. We have staffing arrangements in place, we have secured Chaplaincy funding 2020-2022 and our Senior Class "Boomers" are off to Canberra to explore our hub of Democracy.

In terms of performance our students are amazing, working well to their capacity. In NAPLAN and InCAS, two of our key performance assessments, our students have shone producing solid results across the board in Literacy and Numeracy. How we fare in comparison to "like schools" & WA Public Schools:


