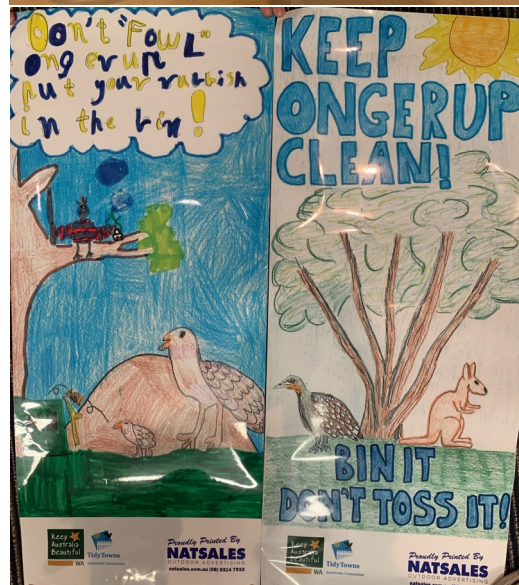
CRC News
