

A girl is discovered hiding in a secret room in the aftermath of a terrible crime. Half-starved and filthy, she won't tell anyone her name, or her age, or where she came from. Maybe she is twelve, maybe fifteen. She doesn't appear in any missing persons file, and her DNA can't be matched to an identity. Six years later, still unidentified, she is living in a secure children's home with a new name, Evie Cormac. When she initiates a court case demanding the right to be released as an adult, forensic psychologist Cyrus Haven must determine if Evie is ready to go free. But she is unlike anyone he's ever met—fascinating and dangerous in equal measure. Evie knows when someone is lying, and no one around her is telling the truth. Meanwhile, Cyrus is called in to investigate the shocking murder of a high school figure-skating champion, Jodie Sheehan, who dies on a lonely footpath close to her home. Pretty and popular, Jodie is portrayed by everyone as the ultimate girl-next-door, but as Cyrus peels back the layers, a secret life emerges—one that Evie Cormac, the girl with no past, knows something about. A man haunted by his own tragic history, Cyrus is caught between the two cases—one girl who needs saving and another who needs justice. What price will he pay for the truth?



CHANGES TO REFUSE SITE PROCESS IN GNOWANGERUP, BORDEN AND ONGERUP

You may be aware and have noticed some works happening at the Gnowangerup, Borden and Ongerup refuse sites. This is part of the Regional and Strategic Waste Management Project funding.

The refuse sites have now all been fenced off and will have a brand new gate system that requires a swipe card for entry. This is to prolong the useful life of the Shire refuse sites beyond 20 years as has been identified through our asset management strategy.

Each property owner will receive a form in the mail in the coming weeks. You will be required to complete this form and bring it to the Shire Administration Office to receive your card. Residents who are not property owners can attend the office to complete the form and receive their card. There is no cost for each initial card but if it is lost, there will be a replacement fee.

Please also be advised that the opening times for the Gnowangerup, Borden and Ongerup refuse sites will be set as below. This allows the Shire to complete maintenance when they are closed.

- High quality videos- we have sample scripts and encourage you all to make one!


