## ONGERUP


Derived from the Aboriginal word "Yonger" meaning "Home of the male kangaroo", is the central town in the Gnowangerup Shire a leading sheep and grain area of W.A.

Situated 220 miles west of Esperance and 95 miles north of Albany on main bitumen highway which passes through the magnificent Stirling Range.
