

THE UNHONEYMOONERS BY CHRISTINA LAUREN.

Writers Lauren Billings and Christina Hobbs are the creators of Christina Lauren and they write the works together, but publish them in the form of one person – Christina Lauren, a combination of their respective first names. Christina Lauren's works primarily belong to the young adult, romance, and contemporary genres. Accordingly, Lauren's books have been featured on the prestigious bestsellers lists of USA Today and the New York Times. Even in terms of international sales, Christina Lauren has achieved quite a lot.






