***Week 6 is children's book week where will dress up as our favourite character and make an edible book snack for afternoon tea!***

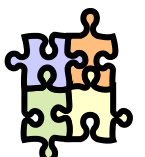
***Week 7 is all about Fathers Day. We will be making some special gifts to bring home to say thank you for our awesome Dads.***

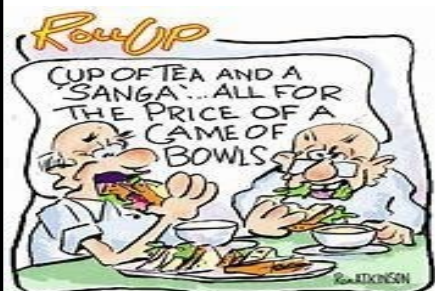

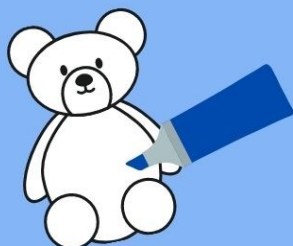
