### SCHOLARSHIP opportunity: A study of the population ecology of *Hakea victoria*

The Friends of the Fitzgerald River National Park (FRNP) are offering a \$5,000 scholarship to an MSc or PhD candidate to study the population ecology of *Hakea victoria* (Royal hakea). This iconic species of the FRNP has declined in density over the past 30 years. The Friends are keen to gain a better understanding of the population dynamics, including reproductive ecology and fire response, of this species to better inform management practices within the park.

The scholarship will be used for operational expenses for the student to travel to the park. Field work is expected to include at least two years data collection. Members of the Friends have extensive knowledge of the FRNP and can provide some logistical support.

A requirement of the scholarship is that a lecture is given by the student to the Friends at the Twertup Field Studies Centre, located in the FRNP, at the completion of the project.
