The 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month has a special significance today. This is the moment hostilities ceased on the Western Front, it became universally associated with the remembrance of those who had died in the war. This first modern world conflict had brought about the mobilisation of over 70 million people and left between 9 and 13 million dead, perhaps as many as one-third of them with no known grave.

At 11.00 am we observe a minutes silence to remember those who have died in conflict especially those who have never returned home.
