Latest news from the Ongerup Museum.

Recently Judy Major and I attended a workshop organised by “Collections WA” which is overseen by the Australian Museums and Gallery Association of WA. (AMaGA WA for short). I have previously attended some of the workshops to getting this programme online, and am very keen for our local Museum to be involved in this as it puts our History on the map as far as Museums are concerned, more people are viewing online these days, so hopefully the more that is seen online, the more visitors will wish to explore our area – even though our doors are closed most of the time, with a bit more interest from the Ongerup community this could be overcome.



What we need from the Ongerup Museum to be able to put details of our Collection on this data system, is firstly some keen photographers – once set up, work on this can be done in your own time. I have done workshops on this so can hold one here at Ongerup to pass on what’s needed for Museum viewing. Also need a few more keen volunteers to help go into more details of our Collection – this includes a better way to describe items in our collection and history on some items. A better description makes viewing more interesting. The Ongerup Museum has over 750 items on record so far and there’s more to accession correctly.

This isn’t all hard, just a little bit of spare time. I wish to hold a gathering early next year sometime, to explain this further to see if you wish to take part. I promise you it’ll only take the small time you can provide, but even that will help immensely. Sections that need to be looked into are the Agricultural, Domestic and Railway descriptions, photos & history.

Judy Major attended this workshop with me and I hope she’s hooked now, so I hope others will find it as interesting, and I’m sure there’s one other museum member so far. So watch this space, wait for the next instalment and DON’T run away, I’m sure we can make this enjoyable if you’re interested in the history of Ongerup

Ongerup Water Catchment refurbishment

The condition of Ongerup’s bitumen catchment has deteriorated over the years and has become densely vegetated in sections. See the attached before photos. This reduces the efficiency/total rainfall collected from the catchment.

The scope of this project is to clear the vegetation and install 8 Hectares of 2mm High-Density Polyethylene Liner (HDPE) over the existing Bitumen Catchment. The key benefits of the HDPE are:

High run-off coefficient, meaning more water is collected per mm of rainfall.

Limited on-going maintenance

Due to the limited rainfall, we have been carting to Ongerup since March 2020. This will remain the case until after construction has finished. We will also need to wait for some rain, so we can sample the water to ensure it meets our Department of Health requirements.

That been said, the recent rain has been welcome. The catchment produced ~3 million litres in November, as a result of those two storms. The water samples after these rains also came back all clear. Currently, the dam is holding a useable 9-10 million litres, which is about 3-4 months of supply.

Merit Lining Systems are installing the HDPE on our behalf. They will be finished by the 18/12/2020.


