Delicious feta pasta

This delicious recipe has been doing the rounds of Facebook - there are many variations to try but this one is pretty good
Ingredients

1 block feta

2 punnets cherry or grape tomatoes (I used 6 large tomatoes)



3 cloves smashed garlic

Extra virgin olive oil

Salt

fresh ground pepper

Thyme

Pasta

Zest of a lemon

Place tomatoes and garlic in an oven proof dish and put

Feta in the centre . Dress with 1/4 cup oil and liberally sprinkle with salt and pepper. Scatter with thyme. Bake in a moderate oven until tomatoes are bursting and feta is browned. Cook approximately 500 grams of pasta either fettuccine or smaller shapes. Drain pasta but leave quite wet. Add to tomato mix and combine..

It can be enjoyed like this or add a cup of chopped cooked chicken or meat of your choice.
