SHIRE OF GNOWANGERUP

STORAGE OF VEHICLES, VESSELS AND MACHINERY ON TOWNSITE PROPERTIES – GNOWANGERUP, BORDEN AND ONGERUP

The Shire of Gnowangerup would like to advise all property owners and residents that over the next few months the Shire will begin a townsite clean-up campaign to ensure our three townsites look fantastic and welcoming to our residents and visitors.

The Shire currently has an [Animals, Environment and Nuisance Local Law 2016](#). Section 3.6 of this local law currently states the following:

3.6 Storage of vehicles, vessels and machinery

- The owner or occupier of a lot shall not—
- (a) store, or allow to remain in public view on any lot, more than 1 vehicle, vessel or machinery (whether licensed or not) in a state of disrepair;
 - (b) store, or allow to remain in public view on any lot, any vehicle, vessel or machinery in a state of disrepair for a period in excess of 1 month;
 - (c) store, or allow to remain in public view on any lot, any vehicle parts, vessel parts or machinery parts (including tyres);
 - (d) wreck, dismantle or break up any vehicle, part or body of a vehicle, vessel or machinery except where performed—
 - (i) inside a building; or
 - (ii) within an area enclosed by a fence or wall of not less than 1.8 metres in height and of such a nature as to screen all vehicles, parts or bodies of vehicles, vessels or machinery from the thoroughfare and from adjoining properties; or
 - (e) wreck, dismantle or break up a vehicle, vessel or machinery so as to cause a nuisance.

The Shire of Gnowangerup is now requesting that all property owners and residents remove all disused vehicles, vessels and machinery from your property by 30th June 2021.

In the upcoming weeks, the Shire will be commencing townsite inspections to identify non-compliant properties that will then be notified accordingly.

This will be our first winter in the Great Southern. My favorite thing about here is that you can go to the beach without worrying about crocodiles. I found out about this position through another mum in school, I am very grateful for the opportunity to work and learn a new skill whilst getting to know more about Ongerup and being a part of the community. My son is already loving the Ongerup childcare! In my spare time I love reading, yoga, exercising and meditation.



MUSEUM BUS TOUR

A group of 11 set off from the museum, on Rose and Bill's school bus to visit Alex Cant's shearing museum on the Broomehill-Kojonup Road, on our annual mothers day tour. We were able to view the section of the Horsepower Highway from Formby South Road to Broomehill and read the associated online notes for the current tractors on display with the promise of more to come. On arrival at the shearing museum that Alex started about 10 years ago on his farm, we were treated to smoko and then a tour of his extensive collection. His collection is housed in a carpeted building that previously served as a bar/pool room and more in a nearby shed. There are some amazing pieces all connected to wool and shearing which definitely interested all us shearers and cockies in the group. Lunch was had at the Jones Building in Broomehill surrounded by many well displayed items. The line of buildings has a long history of operation being built in the 1890's and the last of the shops closing in the 1970's. Jim and Annabel Witham have been operating their café and accommodation for a few years now and they are gradually renovating the grand old buildings. Next stop was a quick walk down the street to the Broomehill Museum where Helen Bignall opened up for us to view their recently renovated displays. Their small group have accessed funds to do up the building, which started as a Roads Board hall and then converted to a church along its life with the addition of the front porch area. They are planning to have a self sufficient museum for visitors to look at the historic displays, without having volunteers on hand. If only we could do that at Ongerup museum as it is hard not to be able to give visitors the opportunity to view the interesting local story and attractions if there isn't a handy person around to open up and give people some extra information. Plus our exhibits are too many and spread to be all housed under glass. The shearing corner in our blue shed is taking shape. We will be running 3 workshops of making fabric wildflowers with June Meredith over the wildflower show time - bookings essential.
