GNOWANGERUP SHIRE MOSQUITO PLAGUE Due to above average rainfall, there is a large mosquito population in the Shire this year. Please be aware that baiting and the use of larvicide has commenced and will continue throughout the summer- our Works Depot is doing a fantastic job keeping on top of this issue. WHAT YOU CAN DO In Western Australia, mosquitoes can transmit Ross River virus, Barmah Forest virus, Kunjin virus and the potentially fatal Murray Valley encephalitis virus. There is currently no cure and no vaccine for any mosquito-borne disease acquired in WA. The only way to prevent infection is to avoid being bitten by mosquitoes. Cover Up – wear long, loose-fitting, light coloured clothing, covering as much of the body as you can. Repel – When outdoors and mosquitoes are present, apply insect repellent containing DEET (diethyltoluamide) or picaridin evenly to exposed skin. Clean Up – simple changes around your home can reduce mosquito breeding. Remove, empty or cover water-holding containers.
