BANNING OF FIRE FIGHTING EQUIPPED TRAILERS DURING FIRE EMERGENCIES

At the Bushfire Advisory Committee (BFAC) General Meeting on the 5th October 2021 the Committee resolved that from October 2021 fire-fighting equipped trailers would no longer be permitted onto the fire ground during a fire emergency.

Experience has shown that these trailers can pose a risk to volunteer safety on properties that have been deep ripped or in bushland, as they can be difficult to reverse out of areas in a hurry.

The Committee recommended to Council that water tankers only be used for water transfer to other appliances fighting the active fire.
