Stevie introduced Sabrina Hahn of WA gardening fame and talkback radio, who can deliver just about anything about soils, bugs, plants and definite no-nos for our area. She also backed up her talk with some good garden stuff for sale for many of us to take home! There was plenty of chance to ask your question at the end of her extensive talk and find out that the second try of growing that pittosporum hedge should be your last! Bottom line was work with what soil and weather conditions you have and give a bit of love along the way in the form of compost, mulch and suitable fertilizer, to keep all available moisture where you want it.

Lunch was catered for by The Country Mixer Candice and son, with some great dishes for all tastes, and plenty of time to get another question or two into Sabrina and exchange with crowd who came from all over a wide area. The kids in the creche were let out for half time and made there presence heard at lunchtime.

Katanning Ecohouse's Ella Maeseppe delivered her inspirational presentation on sustainable living. Her story of reducing the first line of packaging and throwaways to end up with not much to throw away in the end proved that it can be done. She reflected briefly on their family building a sustainably powered straw bale house and how the growing family has adapted their practices and happily live very sustainably. Ella added 'you don't have to be completely crazy to live this way and the kids will take it on when given the right example'.

Ellie Cameron, Albany phycologist, gave a rundown on aspects of mental health and some mindful and self-help ways within our rural lifestyles. She then led us through 10 minutes of sitting meditation and a grounding walk outside on the grass without shoes.

Some of the crowd went on to mingle at Stones Throw Farmhouse nearby with resilience needed for the mozzies! Well done to the organisers on an informative and inspiring day.
