

We wound up 2021 by having the Xmas book club meeting at the Nyabing Pub on Sunday 5th December. Many thanks to Rose for transporting us on the school bus first to the Pingrup Pantry for morning tea then onto Nyabing for lunch. We reviewed this month's book 'The Nightingale' by Kristin Hannah, which was Georgia's choice. The story follows two sisters in France during the German occupation in World War II. Very well written with often shocking descriptions of shocking events. One sister stayed in her occupied village and her husband went to the front line and was captured and sent to POW camp. She had a German officer billeted in her house who she developed a strange closeness to under the circumstances. The other sister, fiery and headstrong, refused to accept the passive role taken by most others and joined with the resisters in their secret organization. The book scored well with the majority of our readers. Average score was 9.3/10 !

We voted on the monthly books read during the year. Way out front was 'Where the Crawdads Sing' by Delia Owens with 18 points and coming in equal 2nd with 9 points each were 'The Wife and the Widow' by Christian White and 'The Nightingale'. With the departure of our long time member Gail earlier in the year, there has been a definite lack of book reporting from the rest of us. Not sure we can fill Gail's big shoes! Welcome to our new members to the group and Merry Xmas to all readers.
