So of course – Ongerup stopped at the club house to congratulate themselves at the end of the day! Next is both the Men & Ladies pennants games on the 22nd Feb, then the Men playing in the league pairs & fours championship to be held at Broomehill on Sun 23rd Feb, and last in the month the Ladies are playing in the Inter League 4s event at Katanning on the 28th-30th Feb. The club Scroungers is an ongoing event every Friday night in Ongerup we'd love to welcome more casual players along for a fund game of bowls, just arrive about 6pm and someone will find you some bowls, just don't wear your boots some flat shoes are the to go.

The Ongerup bowling club would like to put out this notification advised to us from Bowls WA, and we wish for all players and visitors to be advised that we will be following these restrictions.

The Western Australian State Government (the Government) has announced further restrictions on licensed venues, following advice this now directly affects the operations of Western Australian bowling clubs. From the **31/1/2022** all patrons to bowling clubs (including members, spectators and the wider general public) are required to be fully vaccinated.

What area is included in these restrictions? For the avoidance of doubt, the licensed venue will include the clubhouse, playing surface(s) and surrounds, incorporating all areas within the club's boundary.

What does fully vaccinated mean? Fully vaccinated means having received at least two doses of a registered COVID-19 vaccination.

Are there any exemptions? A person is exempt from the vaccination requirement if that person has a medical exemption recorded on the Australian Immunisation Register or for some reason a temporary exemption issued to the person by the Chief Health Officer of Western Australia or their delegate. These MUST be sighted by the HOME Club representative. This restriction starts on Monday 31st January 2022.

What happens if members/patrons are not vaccinated by the 31/1/2022 ? As per the Government regulations they will be unable to enter any bowling club (including the use of greens) in Western Australia. If you are a visitor to the Ongerup club, this includes at all time, ie; scroungers nights, social nights or just joining us for a drink after play, please bring your Vaccination statement or Certificate with you, either digital or a paper copy. 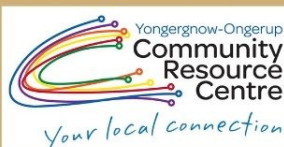
