

Book Club



Champagne was required for the first Book Club of the year, as there was much to celebrate and catch up on, which also meant that the actual book club part of Book Club didn't start until late. We reviewed Roz's choice "The Nazis Knew my Name" by Magda Hellinger and Maya Lee with David Brewster. This is a memoir of extraordinary survival in Auschwitz by Magda Hellinger, who saved an untold number of lives at Auschwitz through everyday acts of courage, kindness and ingenuity.

As Magda recounts her experience we find out that she was constantly walking a dangerously fine line: using every possible opportunity to save lives while avoiding suspicion by the SS, and risking torture or execution. Through her bold intelligence, sheer audacity, inner strength and shrewd survival instincts, she was able to rise above the horror and cruelty of the camps and build pivotal relationships with the women under her watch, and even some of Auschwitz's most notorious Nazi senior officers including the Commandant, Josef Kramer.

We all had the same reaction to this story-harrowing. Although we all dealt with this in different ways, we all left asking ourselves the same question-"Would we have survived if we were in those circumstances?". Average rating was 7/10.
