And the flies are into his ewes

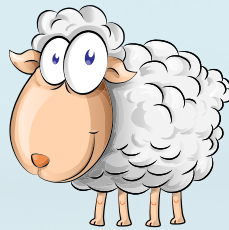
St Peter was an old shearer himself

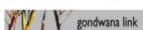
