### Community Fox shoot

Last Friday night we held our annual fox shoot in partnership with NSPNR. An amazing 16 teams registered from Ongerup, Borden and Gnowangerup. Teams were asked to take photos and geolocate where they shot their prey to build up a picture of the location of vermin in the shire. A huge tally of 251 foxes, 7 cats and 88 rabbits were culled during the night. After the count at the Ongerup tip participants joined the community for a hearty breakfast and presentations. Nearly 80 people enjoyed the breakfast at Yongergnow which was held outside for the first time.

The big winners for the day were the Borden team of Amelup Cat Cullers, followed by Gensor and the 3foxeteers came third. Biggest cat was shot by Gensor weighing in at 5.15 kg, biggest fox shot by Corackerup killers came in at 8.2 kg. Most cats was tied between Gensor and Corackerup killers with 3 each. The 3foxeteers had the most points per person with 60 each. The best ute went to Jye Duggan. Thankyou to everyone who entered, our breakfast cooks and especially to the team at Yongergnow and NSPNR, a very successful event.
